Established in 2015, Yozmot Atid aims to create a more sustainable and equal Israeli society, one woman entrepreneur at a time. We work to reduce socioeconomic disparities in Israel by empowering women to establish micro enterprises, on a path towards financial independence.

Each year, 1,000 diverse women - Jewish, Arab, secular, ultra-Orthodox, new immigrants, Bedouin, Druze and others, mainly from low socioeconomic backgrounds, enroll in our professional program. Yozmot Atid's graduates acquire the necessary know-how and support to establish their own business, improving their financial situation and that of their families, children and wider communities, long-term.
